Sertoma's focus is to assist those with speech, hearing, and communication disorders. Therefore, the Sertoma Club of Greenwood intends to award (1) \$2,000 one-year scholarship to a student who is hearing impaired or planning on majoring in an area related to speech and hearing. The remaining (3) \$2,000 one-year scholarships will be open to studies other than speech, hearing, or communication categories. Any student that has been accepted for the 21st Century scholarship will not be eligible for the Sertoma Club of Greenwood scholarship.

The criteria for selecting the winners is prioritized as follows:

- 1. Financial need
- 2. Academic achievement
- 3. School and community involvement
- 4. Content of essay

Applications must be received by March 15, 2024. Applications will not be accepted after this date.
